

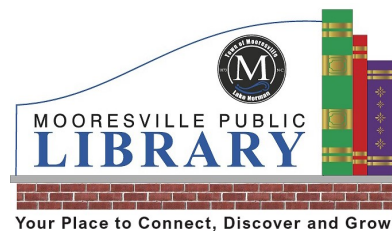
Other stuff TAB has done in the last few years...

What is Teen Advisory Board (TAB)?

Teen Advisory Board (TAB for short) is a group of teens that meets bimonthly at the library. TAB works with the Teen/YA Librarian to improve teen programs, the teen area of the library, and the collection. Basically, the mission of TAB is to have a voice and help turn the library into a place you and other teens want to be!

When is Teen Advisory Board (TAB)?

TAB meets on the first and third Tuesday of each month @ 5:00-6:30 in the Selma Burke Room at the library.

Who is eligible for TAB & When Can I start?

TAB is open to any student who is 13 or older and/or are in grades 8-12 or equivalent (whether they attend public or private school, or are home-schooled). You must be a Mooresville/Iredell County resident. Any TAB meeting can be your first!

What do I get out of it?

- A voice in deciding what cool stuff the library can offer teens
- Volunteering on TAB looks great on college and job applications
- A chance to make new friends outside of school
- Snacks!
- The eternal and dying gratitude of the Teen/YA Librarian

What do you actually *do* at a TAB meeting?

TAB members work as a team with the Teen/YA Librarian to advise, plan, and implement teen programs. This includes helping plan summer reading & prizes. Sometimes TAB will even plan events themselves!

TAB members also do stuff like....

- Read Advance Reader copies of New YA/Teen Books and suggest whether the library should buy them or not.
- Help make displays and decorate the Teen area at MPL

What if I can't make it to every meeting?

That's totally okay! Sometimes you might have an event at school, a family conflict, or too much homework. All we ask is that you come when you can, and try to let us know when you can't.
