Mooresville includes 26 square miles with an ETJ of 72 square miles. In 2021, the population of the Town of Mooresville was 51,594. An estimated 18,000 additional individuals visit Mooresville daily.

Mitchell Community College provides higher education and technical training opportunities, with multiple four-year public and private colleges and universities within a one hour commute.
